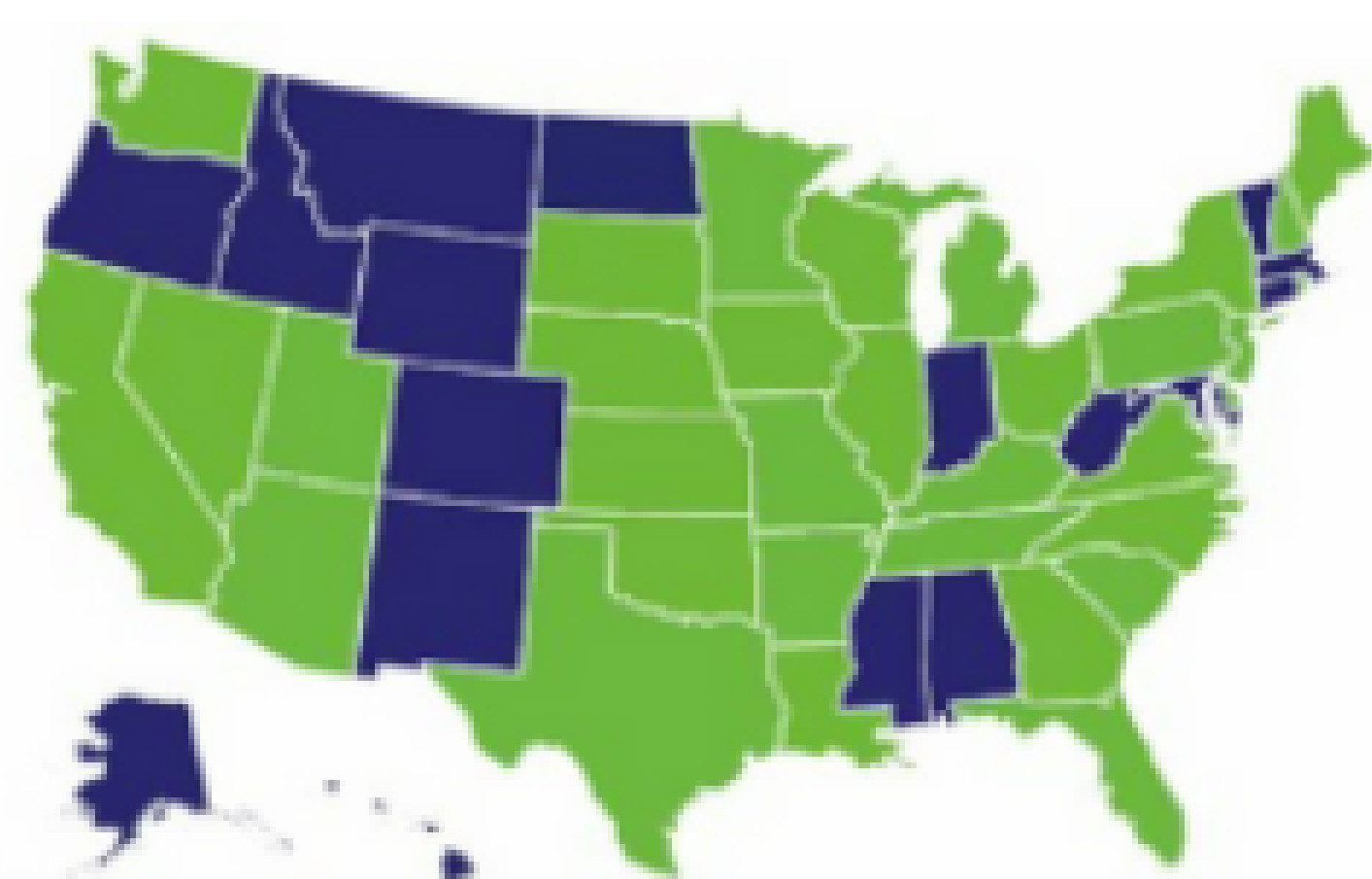
258 individuals with CHARGE sponsored to attend conference for free
