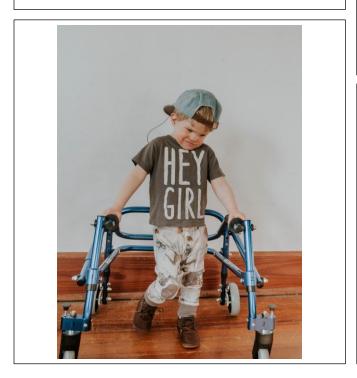
## Courtney Scholl -Nebraska
