Cullen has attended CHARGE Conferences in Chicago where he supported Jason to attend his first CHARGE conference. This was an experience of a lifetime which has prompted Jason to reapply to attend this year. Cullen also attended in Orlando where he presented "A Day in the Life," that highlighted adult transition and reaching goals in a supported independent living program.
