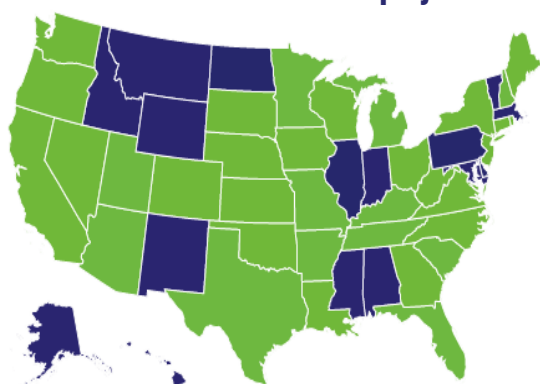
440 FREE clear face masks distributed to members
