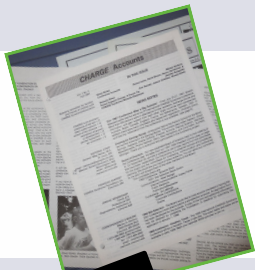

**Monthly newsletters emailed to over 4,400 people across dozens of countries. Over 8,700 people connected through our Facebook Support Group.**



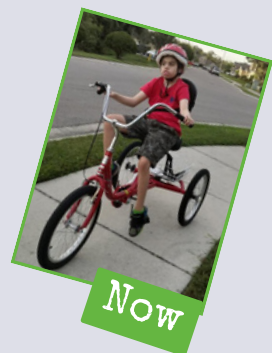

**A Board was established with 3 founders - Meg Hefner, Marion Norbury, and Sandra Davenport - and 2 parents of children with CHARGE syndrome.**

**We have a Board of 8, 5 Advisors, 4 staff members, a Scientific and Professional Advisory Board, and many volunteers, all of whom make everything we do possible. Our outreach and liaison programs provide life-changing support to thousands each year, our Family Assistance Programs provide direct assistance to hundreds of individuals with CHARGE and our biennial Conference is an unmatched, life-changing opportunity for experts and families to learn from each other. The Foundation provided 56 families with Medical Travel Assistance, \$24,000 in Sibling Scholarships, and awarded 72 individuals with CHARGE with adaptive bikes, therapy and camps through the Ethan Wolfe Recreation Assistance Program.**
