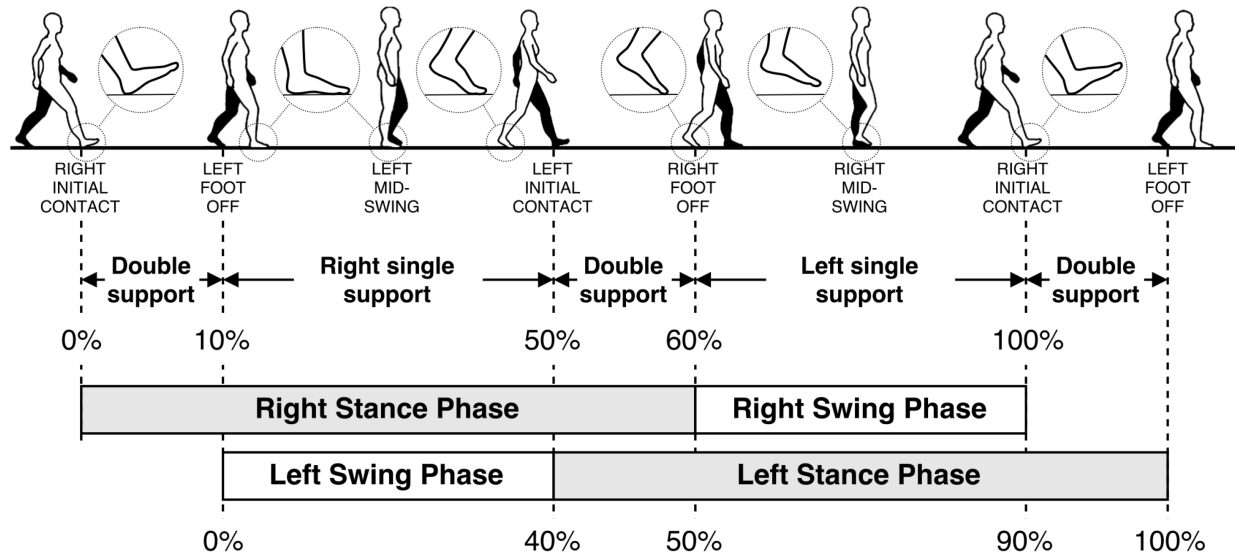


Welcome to the 16th International CHARGE Syndrome Conference
